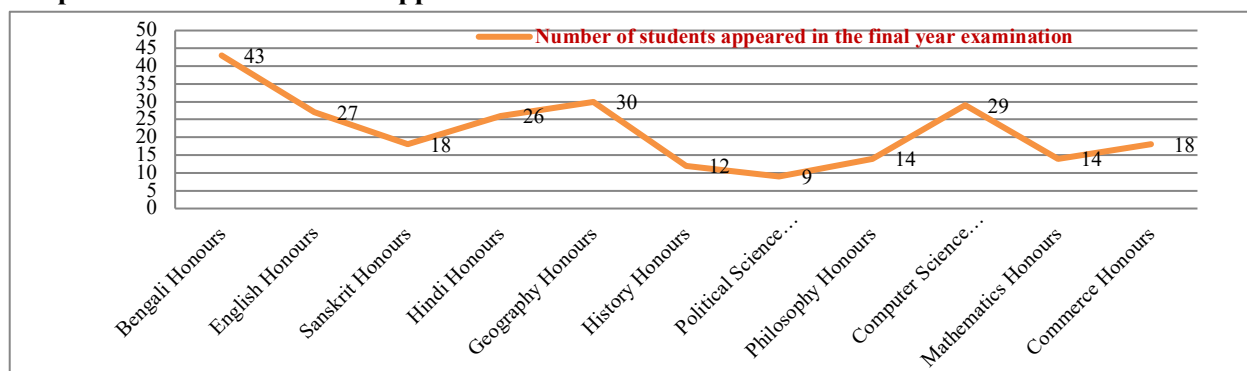

ANALYSIS OF RESULTS OF STUDENTS SESSION: 2018-19

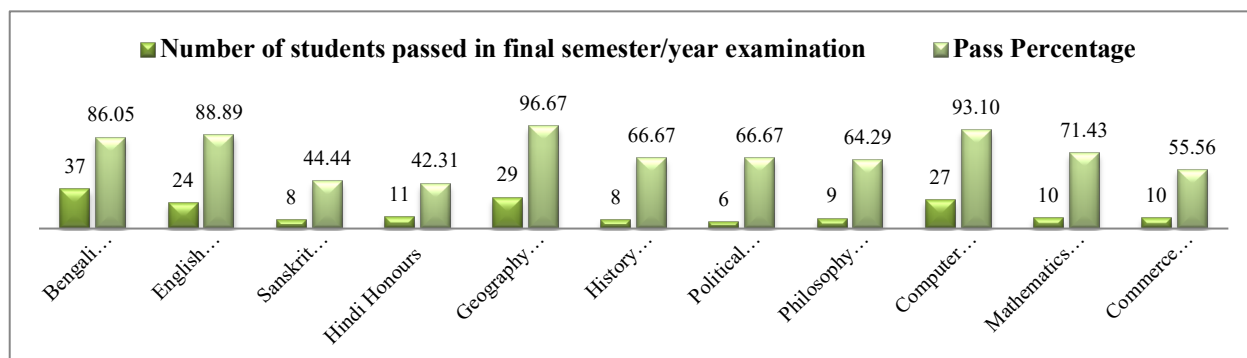

Graph 1: Number of students appeared in the final examination in 2018-19



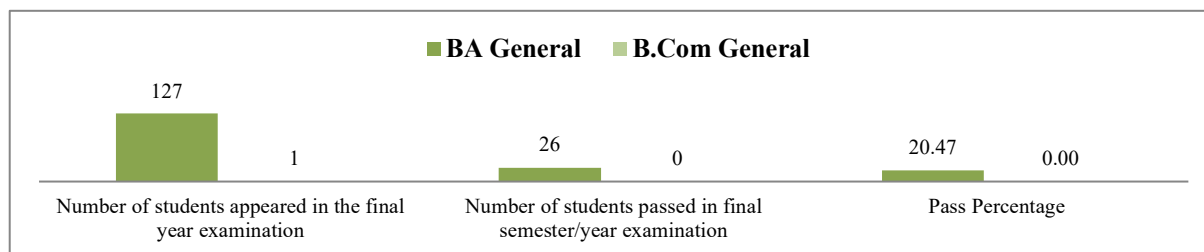
