

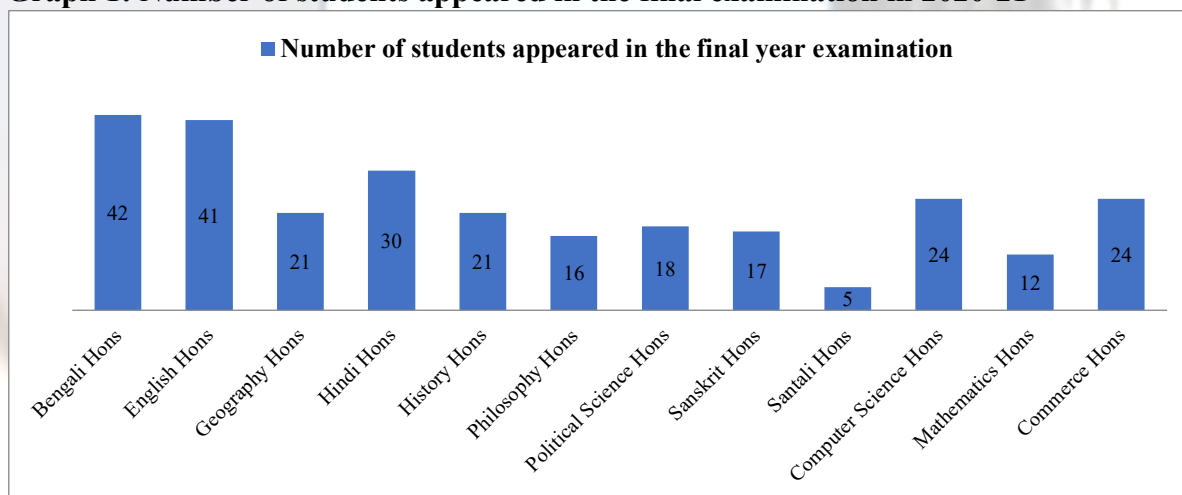

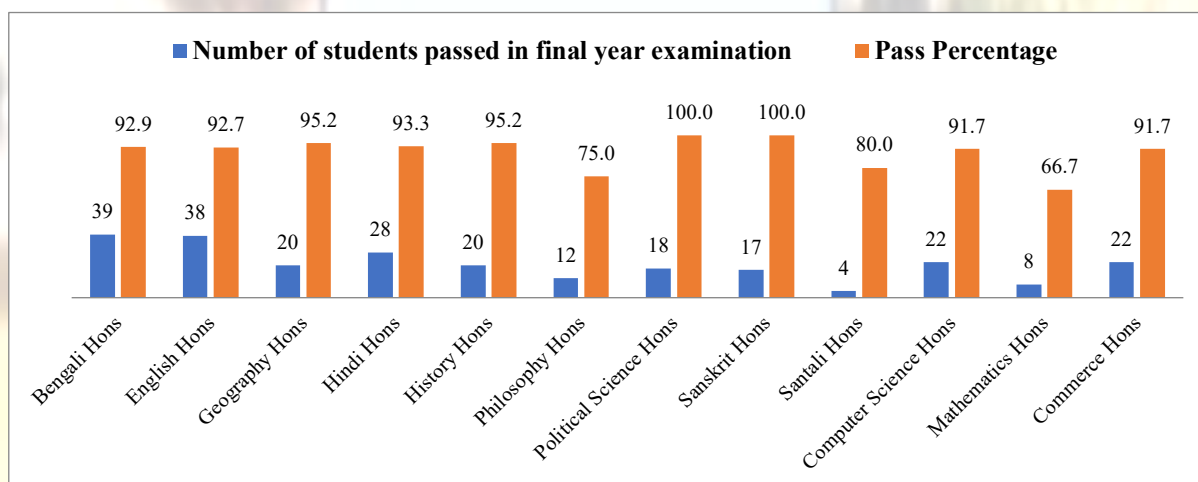

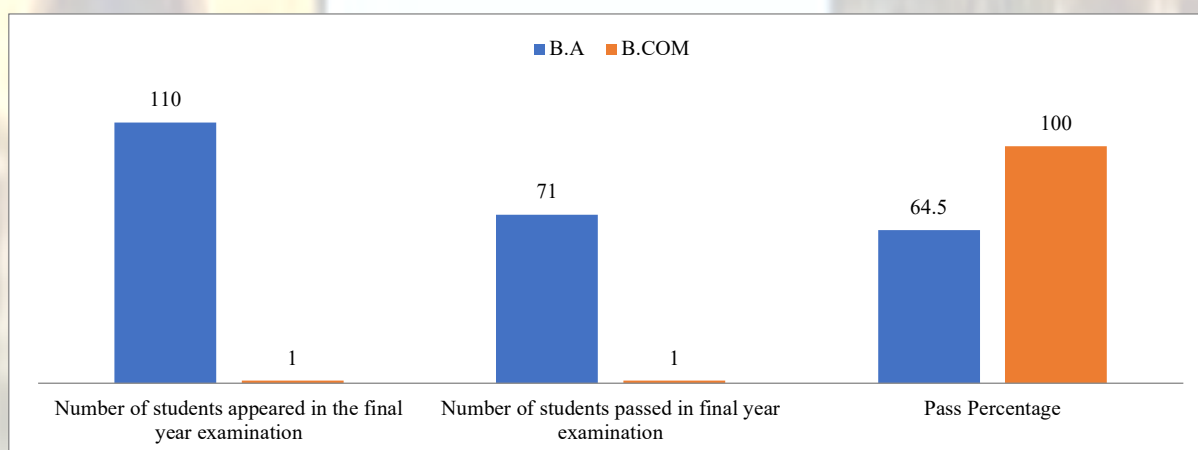
**Graph 1: Number of students appeared in the final examination in 2020-21**



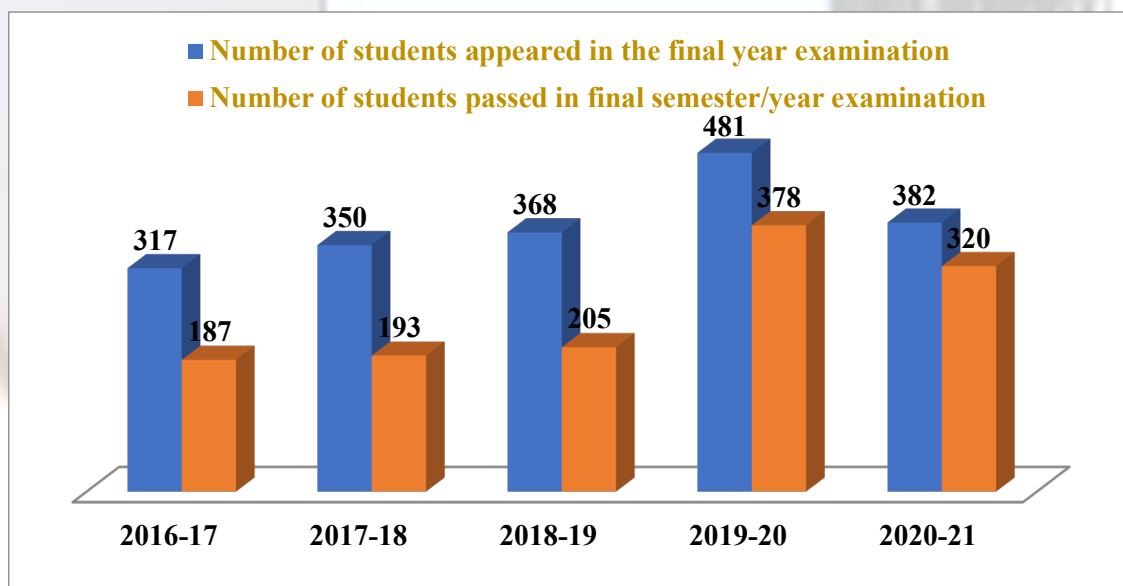
**Graph 2: Number of students passed and Percentage in the final examination in 2020-21**



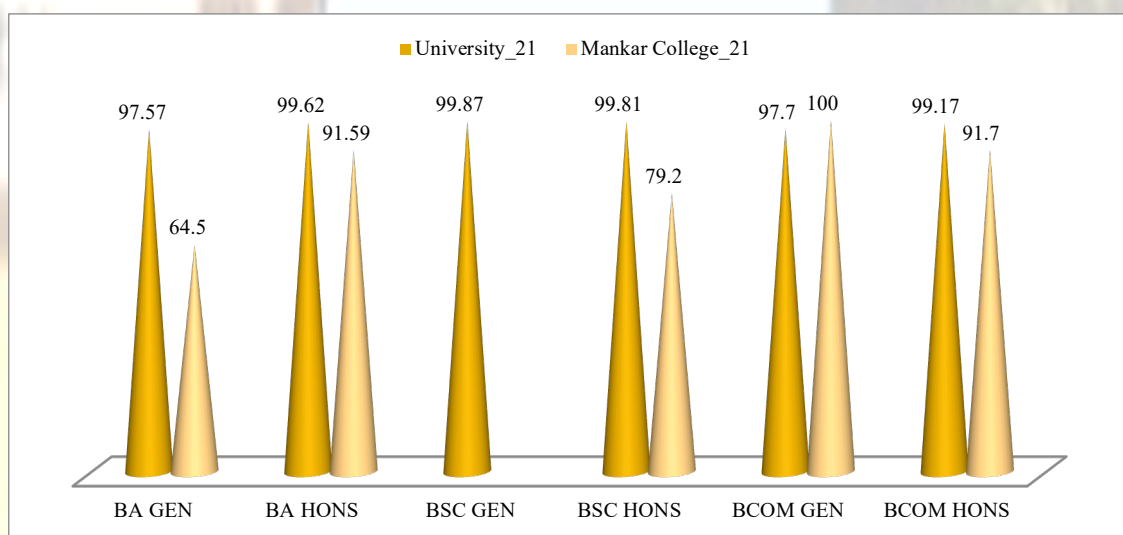
**Graph 3: Performance of BA/B.Sc/B.Com students in the final examination in 2020-21**
