

R. SUBHAS CHANDRA BOSE DEAD

SUCCUMBS TO INJURY
FROM AIR CRASH

ANNOUNCEMENT BY JAP
NEWS AGENCY

TUE, AUG. 23.—The death of Mr. Subhas Chandra Bose
was announced today by the Japanese News Agency.
Agency added that Mr. Bose died in a Japanese hospital
where he had been receiving medical treatment.

Mr. Bose, head of the Provisional Government
of India, left Singapore on August 14 by air for Tokyo for talks with the
Japanese leaders. He was admitted to a hospital there at about
the time of his arrival. He died at 1 p.m. on August 23. He was given maximum care in hospital
where he died of multiple injuries.

NOT TO SURPRISE

He was admitted to the hospital under the name of Mr. Sato. The Japanese News Agency said that he died of his injuries due to an accident or sudden illness.

NEW DELHI, Aug. 23.—The war is now half the problem

Japanese proper government, and records of large

In 1946 posters began to appear on the houses of

American Correspondent Says Netaji Is Alive


In an exclusive report to the "National Call," Mr. Alfred
