Concept note

Since its invention in the nineteenth century, the nation state has been at the heart of political discourse. Imagined as a political entity congruent with the State nation emerged in historical discourse as a body of congruent geopolitical boundary and cultural intercourse. Recent years have witnessed reevaluation of the idea of nation moving beyond the strict boundaries of exclusivity. Increased material and ideational flow across borders and the rise of the idea of a 'global local' has occasioned the reevaluation. New conceptual themes like transcultural, transnational and interbraided experience have gained primacy in recent discussions. In the light of these new theoretical upheavals, the uniqueness of national imagery needs reexamining. The purpose of the conference is to question the idea of the nation in light of these new findings which sets uniqueness against interbraided experiences of people across borders within Asia. The two days International Symposium intends to address these muiltiplicities and the chaotic pattern that exists within it.

We welcome original research papers in consonance with the theme in English and Bengali. The papers can explore the following aspects of interbraided lived experience:
